The Club also organises friendly games on Sundays, enabling members to visit clubs and build friendships that would otherwise not be possible.

The Club is affiliated to the Cleveland County Bowling Association which enables members to nominate to represent the County and also to enter the County competitions.

Over the years and since the formation of the County Bowling Association a number of members have been appointed as senior officers of it, a number have represented the County, a number have been successful in the County competitions and some have reached the very top by winning the National English Bowling Federation competitions.

Due to the level of activity at the Club, we are always on the lookout for keen and enthusiastic new members, whether experienced bowlers, or novices who want to learn the game and you can be assured that you will be greeted by friendly faces and many opportunities to play bowls.
